DON'T FORGET:

- Bring copies of coggins and rabies for the show chairman to keep
- 2. ALL riders must wear a helmet, please bring your helmet to the registration booth
- 3. Be ready at the gate for each class!

Show Policies:

 FFA rules will be used as guidelines for this show, however, some rules may be changed to the needs of the arena. The show chairman will have the final decision.

A \$2/class late fee will be assessed for late registrations (after 8:45 am for Western and after 11:30 am for English, after noon for Gymkhana). This WILL be enforced!

- Points are given to each horse & rider combination. Each combination must have its own number. A horse/rider combination cannot cross skill divisions for points (e.g. walk trot combination cannot enter junior division).
- Proper clothing is required in ALL classes. <u>ASTM approved helmet must be worn by all</u> <u>riders regardless of age or discipline</u>. Helmets <u>must be presented at the registration desk.</u>
- Proof of Rabies Vaccination & Negative Coggins (rabies must be dated within 12months of show and Coggins must be dated within 24 months of show) are required and copies will be collected at each show.
- 6. Kickers must wear a red ribbon on tail.
- In all disputes the Show Chairman's word is FINAL. In the ring the Judge's decision is FINAL.
- 8. Classes may be added, dropped or combined as entries warrant.
- 9. Horses and ponies must be sound
- Classes will run on time and will not wait for any reason. It is your responsibility to be ready at the gate. Tack changes are acceptable with notice.
- 11. No verbal ringside coaching by anyone. Cheering is allowed during games.
- The chairman holds the right to cancel any show, or class, that might put any person or animal at risk due to weather or other factors.
- 13. To qualify for the championship, a horse/rider combination must enter **four (4)** of the championship classes in the division.
