FFA Points Policies:

1. The treasurer and advisors are responsible for tracking FFA points.
2. 10 points $=\$ 1.00$ that may used for FFA trips, to purchase official dress or to pay dues. Other use of FFA points is up to the discretion of the advisors.
3. You cannot earn FFA points for a trip/event which is being paid for using FFA points.
4. Special committees must be assigned a deadline for task completion at the time the committee is formed.
5. All point allocations are up to the discretion of the FFA advisor(s) responsible for the event or task points are earned for.
6. Special events not listed below may be eligible for FFA points at the discretion of the FFA advisors.
7. All FFA points are liquidated at the time of high school graduation.

Member of the Month:

The member who has gained the most points in each month will be the member of the month.

The member will get a small token, and will be profiled in the display case.
Someone cannot be member of the month more than two months in a row.

In the event of a tie, both members will be recognized as member of the month. In the case of a multiple tie, the advisors will decide to recognize all members, or recognize no members.

The FFA Officer team is responsible for maintaining the display case.
